The cost of any changes or additions will be at the local rate at the time of the amendment and must be done by the passenger.

AIRLINES:

ITINERARY 2010

March 23, Tuesday - Depart from Miami to Tel Aviv

March 24, Wednesday -Tel Aviv to Galilee
Arrive Ben Gurion Airport in the morning. Leave Tel Aviv heading North, first stop is at Caesarea, once capital of the Roman province, see Roman and Crusader remains and the harbor from which St. Paul was taken prisoner to Rome. Continue to Mt. Carmel at Haifa. Leave Haifa via the Carmel viewing the Druze villages and then to Mukhraka for a spectacular view of the northern region. Overnight in Nazareth. (B,D)

March 25, Thursday – Galilee Area
Take the boat from Tiberias to Capernaum; there you will see an ancient synagogue and St. Peter's house which was later converted into a church. Also by the shore you will visit Tabgha with the Church of Peter's Primacy and the ancient mosaic of the Loaves and Fishes. Continue to the Mount of Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount is remembered. In the afternoon stop at the Jordan River for the traditional baptismal site of Jesus. Return to Nazareth for overnight. (B,D)

March 26, Friday - Cana, Nazareth, Tabor, Megiddo
Go to Cana, scene of the first miracle and visit the Church of the Wedding. Then go to Nazareth and see the oldest Church of the Annunciation with Mary's Well. Continue to Mt. Tabor site of the Transfiguration. Proceed to Megiddo overlooking the Jezreel Valley and considered the Armageddon of the New Testament. Finally to your hotel in Nazareth overnight. (B,D)

March 27, Saturday – Nazareth to Jerusalem
Leave Nazareth down the Jordan Valley. Visit Bet Shean, biblical Scythopolis to visit the Roman theatre, paved road and the excavations. Continue to Jericho to see the excavations of the oldest city in the world. View the Mt. of Temptation. Drive to Jerusalem and stop in Wadi Kelt to view St George's Monastery. Proceed to Jerusalem for overnight. (B,D)

March 28, Sunday - Bethlehem, Palm Sunday walk
Drive down the Kidron Valley and see the Pool of Siloam, and St. Peter in Gallicantu built over the palace of the High Priest Caiaphas. On Mount Zion visit the tomb of David, the Upper room and the Church of Dormition. Drive south to Bethlehem to see the Church of the Nativity, and below the cave-stable of Jesus' birth. Have lunch with Palestinian families in Beit Sahour.
At 14:00, join the Palm Sunday walk at the Mt of Olives. Back to Jerusalem for overnight. (B, D)

March 29, Monday - Old City, Christian shrines
Enter the Old City through the Dung Gate to visit the Western Wall, the Temple Area with the Al-Aksa mosque and the Dome of the Rock where Abraham was going to sacrifice his son. Stop at the Jewish Quarter to visit the Cardo. See the Pool of Bethesda where the angel ruffled the water, and St. Anne's Church, traditional birthplace of Jesus' mother. Visit the Convent of the Zion Sisters. Leave the Old City through the Bazaars. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B,D)

March 30, Tuesday - Massada, Qumran, Dead Sea Area
Drive to Qumran where the Essene enclave was and see the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were hidden. Weather permitting, swim in the Dead Sea. Stop at Massada and take a cable car up the mountain. Proceed to Jerusalem for overnight. (B,D)

March 31, Wednesday - Emmaus, Abu Ghosh
Today we visit Emmaus and Abu Ghosh, Back to Jerusalem for some free afternoon. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B,D)

April 1, Thursday - Jerusalem
Visit the Israel Museum and view the Dead Sea scrolls and the Model of Jerusalem as it was during the period of the Second Temple which stood at the time of Jesus. Continue to Ein Karem to visit the Church of St. John the Baptist and the Visitation. Drive to Bethany, home of Martha, Mary and Lazarus. See the wine-press. Afternoon, attend the foot washing service in the Armenian Cathedral. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B,D)

April 2, Friday - Jerusalem
Early morning walk the Stations of the Cross to the Church of The Holy Sepulcher. Back to the hotel for breakfast. Drive to the Mount of Olives for a wonderful view of Jerusalem. See the Place of Ascension and the Pater Noster Church, and view the Palm Sunday road. At the foot of the hill see the Garden of Gethsemane with its ancient olive trees and the Church of All Nations. Afternoon, join prayers at the St George's Cathedral for the Good Friday. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B,D)

April 3, Saturday Orthodox Easter
AM join the Cathedral Congregation on their walk to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher for the Orthodox Holy Fire Service of Easter Saturday. Return to your hotel for the balance of the day at leisure. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B,D)

April 4, Sunday – Easter Sunday
Morning, join prayers at the St. George's Cathedral for the
Easter Sunday Service.
Afternoon free. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B,D)

April 5, Monday - City of David, Citadel, Ophel Gardens
Today we visit the City of David, Warren's Shaft and
Hezekkiah's Tunnel. Continue to Citadel of David. On to
the Ophel Gardens. Return to your hotel in Jerusalem to
freshen up. Dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in
Jerusalem. (B,D)

April 6, Tuesday – Tel Aviv, Miami
11 AM departure from Tel Aviv a late arrival in Miami.
(B,L,D)
