

## **Our Little Roses Foreign Mission Society Young Professionals Membership & Eligibility Requirements**

### **Membership Eligibility**

Applicants from sophomore year of high school to age 35 may request membership.

### **Membership Expectations & Responsibilities**

- Make Our Little Roses a top personal philanthropic priority with the goal of securing financial support\* for Our Little Roses Ministries through personal resources or through the cultivation of new donor relationships.  
**High School Student Goal: \$100**  
**Undergraduate Student Goal: \$150**  
**Graduate Student Goal: \$300**  
**Employed Young Professional Goal: \$500\*\***
- Participate in one or more committees (Fundraising, Advocacy, Social Media/Communications, Recruitment, Honduran Professionals) to carry out initiatives in support of the OLRYPG.
- Attend quarterly OLRFMS YP Virtual Meetings (if a quarterly meeting cannot be attended for some reason, the member should notify beforehand and will be required to attend a monthly Leadership meeting in order to stay connected and show commitment to the YP Group)
- Attend OLRFMS YP events and activities as much as able, including the OLRFMS YP Annual Meeting in Miami.
- As possible, visit OLR in San Pedro Sula, Honduras with a member of the OLRFMS YP or as part of a mission team.

\*If the YP Member already personally procures funds for individual sponsorship of a girl at OLR (or Universal Sponsorship), then their goal will be reduced by 50%. Family, church, or other group sponsorships are ineligible for this exception (ex. An employed YP already committed to paying to sponsor a girl has a financial give/get fundraising goal reduced to \$250).

\*\*Employed young professionals in their first-year post-graduation should strive to meet this goal, but members may request consideration for a waiver of one year to remain at their previous financial goal.
