

OLRFMS Ambassadors Council

Job Descriptions and Expectations

Purpose: The Ambassadors Council of Our Little Roses Foreign Mission Society, Inc. will support the organization's mission and needs by providing advice and support to the OLRFMS Board of Directors, particularly in the areas of fundraising, outreach and donor relations. The Ambassadors Council has no formal legal responsibilities or decision-making authority.

Major responsibilities:

- Support the Organization's mission, purpose, goals, policies, and programs, while understanding its strengths and needs.
- Actively engage in fundraising and outreach, acting as an ambassador for OLRFMS.
- Provide input to strengthen fundraising programs and outreach services.

Membership on Council: Ambassador terms shall be three-years, renewable once if mutually agreed upon. Terms will be staggered to ensure continuity and adequate numbers on the Council. Members will be asked to maintain the confidentiality of certain information that may be shared by the Board in order for the Council to do its work. Council members understand that they represent OLRFMS and they must maintain personal conduct of high integrity and protect the identity of the girls at the Mission.

Expectations of the Ambassadors Council members:

- Serve as an ambassador and help to promote OLRFMS' mission to a broader community.
- Make Our Little Roses a personal philanthropic priority with the goal of securing a minimum of \$3,000 of support for Our Little Roses Ministries through personal resources or through the cultivation of new donor relationships.
- Participate in one or more committees of the organization to carry out fundraising and other initiatives in support of the work of OLRFMS and the ministries of OLRM.
- Assist in the recruitment of additional donors, supporting churches, Council members, and volunteers.
- Attend and support special activities of the Board and organization including fundraising events and retreats.
- Be willing to organize and/or make presentations (virtually or in person) to church and civic organizations, educating them on the purpose and goals of OLRFMS and asking for their support. (Training and materials will be provided.)
- As possible, visit OLR in San Pedro Sula, Honduras with a member of the Board or as part of a mission team.
- As possible attend one annual day-long meeting in Miami, usually in October, with presentations by OLRFMS' Executive Director and the Executive Director and Founder of OLRM, in addition to other informational presentations, fundraising workshops and working sessions.
